Subject: Tuner Cleaning

Thought you might pass this along to all your customers. I finally found the product that really works to clean the carbon ring from the inside of the Bucks tuner or any of the counter bored tuners for that matter.

I use Carb Out (see picture).

1) I use a cotton ball pressed up against the sides of the inside of the tuner (see picture) and soak it with Carb Out (does not take much).

2) I use another cotton ball on top of that one to prevent evaporation, leave the rifle alone for a couple of hours.

3) Taking both cotton balls out,lightly wiping the inside of the tuner, carbon ring is gone.Surfaces are clean and look new. Also cleans powder residue from the barrel crown. This also leaves a fine coating on metal which makes the next cleaning easier.

(Speedy says the need to clean a tuner is because the weight of the carbon effects the tune, and the carbon also effects the harmonics. Both these will cause the tuner to loose its tune. Remedy: Clean your tuners !)
